From a photographer's point of view there is no such thing as bad weather – if it's sunny then beaches look good, if it's cloudy then forest images look great. Best of all, if it's really stormy there is the potential for great images because good skies can make or break a photo. When storms clear and pass over then you can get really atmospheric light: so when the weather is 'bad' get your camera out and be ready.

PRINT COMPETITION

- The maximum number of entries per member is 4 images per competition. A maximum of 2 entries may be submitted in any one class (colour & mono).
